Fabric Collage – A Contemporary Approach to Piecework, Appliqué and Quilting

Love textiles? Want to join the slow-stitching movement?

This 3-hour class covers the basics of selecting fabrics, playing with color and texture, creating a design, and assembling the elements into an expressive composition. Plus, learn about recycling textiles and how to reuse your favorite clothing or linens in a sustainable way. Students will make a small decorative pillow. (Hand-stitched) All materials are included, and students may bring their own fabrics to work with.

About the Teacher

Julia E. Pfaff has been quilting her entire life and has successfully turned a family tradition into a contemporary art form. A recent recipient of a 2019-2020 Professional Artist Fellowship from the Virginia Museum of Fine art, she has also received two different Individual Artist's Fellowships from the Virginia Commission for the Arts. Starting in 1987, her work has been included in numerous prominent national art quilt exhibitions. She is an educator and studio artist and teaches at both the community and college level. Her quilts can be found in numerous national collections and publications.
